CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

Participants are requested to submit abstracts not later than **AUGUST 31, 2009**, to the Conference Secretariat. Abstracts will be reviewed and assigned to appropriate sessions. Authors will be notified regarding acceptance. Only limited number of papers will be scheduled for oral presentation. Authors will be informed about the method of presentation.

Faxed abstracts will not be accepted.

Types of contributions:

Original Research Papers and Review Articles are accepted.



GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS

1. Use A4 paper, with 2.5cm margin on all four sides.
2. Abstracts should not exceed 400 words and must be submitted in English.
3. Use typescript Times New Roman 12 throughout, line spacing 1.0 and justified.
4. Title of the paper should be in upper case and aligned centrally.
5. Presenting authors name should be highlighted or indicated by asterisk (*).

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF FULL-TEXT ARTICLES

Manuscripts in general should follow the format adopted by **WORLD'S POULTRY SCIENCE JOURNAL** and be organized in the following order:

- Title ● Name(s) of author(s) ● Complete postal address(es) of affiliations (Full telephone and fax numbers, and e-mail address of the corresponding author in the footnote appearing in the first page containing the title) ● Present address(es) of author(s) if applicable, in the footnote appearing at the bottom of the first page containing the title) ● Abstract (should not be more than 400 words) ● Key words (indexing terms), normally 3-6 items.
- Introduction ● Materials and methods ● Results
- Discussion ● Conclusion ● References ● Acknowledgements and any additional information concerning research grants, etc.

The full text should be sent before OCTOBER 15, 2009.

ONLINE SUBMISSION:

Online submission to IV World Waterfowl Conference can be done through a step-by-step uploading of files. Authors should select a set of classifications for their papers from a given list, as well as a category designation (Research Paper or Review article). The articles should be original and not published elsewhere. Submission also implies that all authors have approved the paper for release and are in agreement with its content. Upon acceptance of the article by the conference, the copyright of the article is automatically transferred to the conference or WPSA.

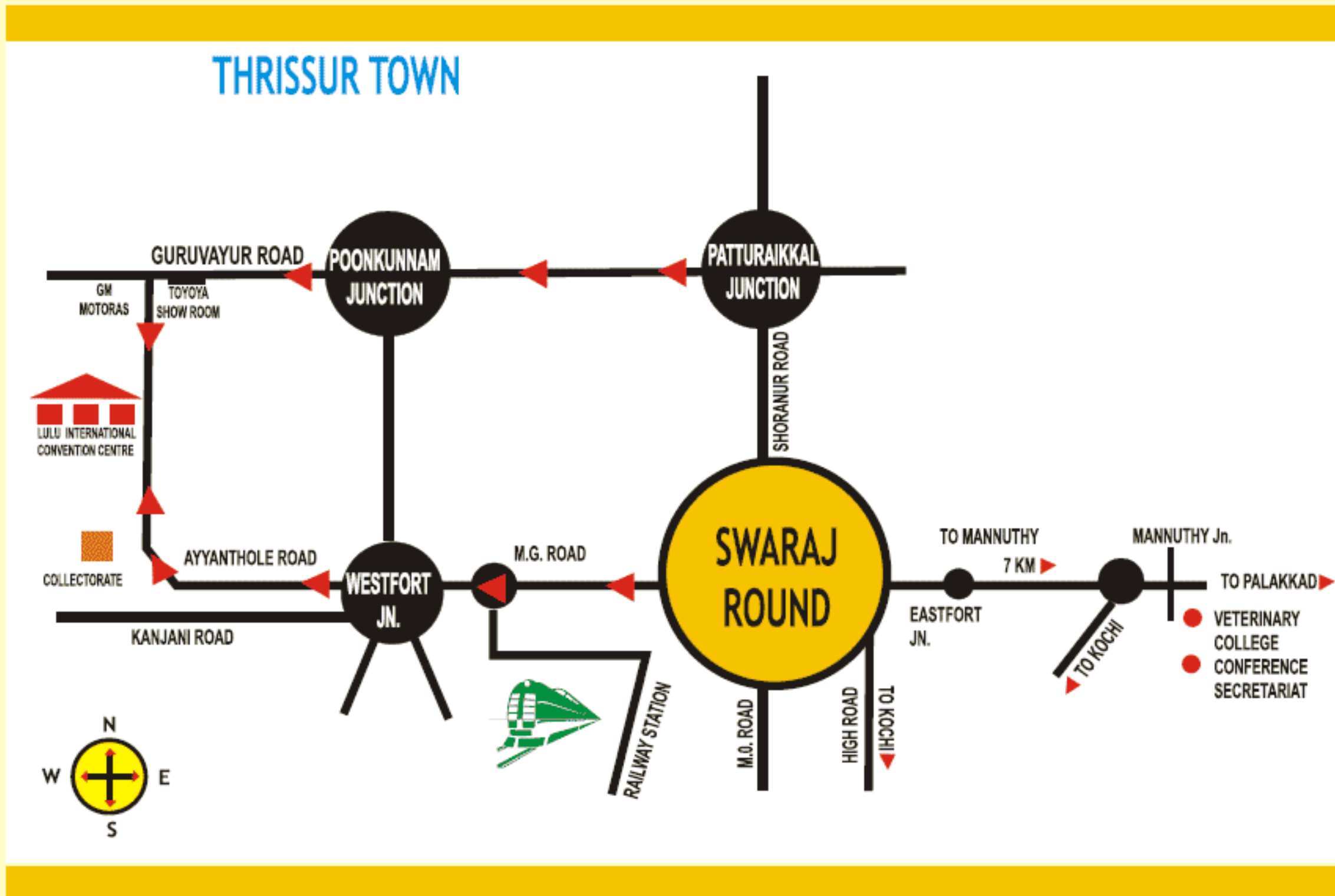

How to Reach the Venue: (LULU INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION CENTRE)



Rail and Road:

Thrissur (Trichur) is well connected with rest of the towns in India by road as well as rail. The nearest railway station is Thrissur, which is about 5 km south-east from venue.

By Air:

The nearest airport is Cochin (presently known as Nedumbassery / Kochi) International Airport, which is situated about 55 km away from Thrissur. The airport operates domestic as well as international flights. Prepaid taxis are available from the airport to the venue. Calicut (presently known as Kozhikkode /Karippur) International Airport is situated about 100km away from Thrissur. Prepaid taxis are available from the airport to reach the venue.
